

2021 Lifeguard Certification Classes

Splash Pool Management teaches American Red Cross Lifeguard Certification classes in a blended learning format, which includes approximately 7 hours of independent eLearning and 2 days of in-person instruction. Certifications are valid for 2 years from class completion date.

Course Prerequisites:

- Must be able to complete eLearning on your own and also attend both sessions of the in-person instruction
- Must be at least 15 years old by the last day of class
- Must be able to tread water for 2 minutes using legs only
- Must be able to swim 300 yards continuously, using 2 strokes, breaststroke or freestyle
- Must be able to perform a surface dive at 7-10 feet and retrieve a 10-pound object

Cost:

The American Red Cross Lifeguard Certification class is \$250. This includes online access to the Lifeguard manual, CPR mask, and first aid supplies. **Payment is required before the first day of in-person instruction to reserve your spot.**

If the student cannot pass the swim test course prerequisites on the first day of in-person instruction, the class cost will be returned. Once the student has passed the swim test prerequisites, there will be **NO REFUND** if the student does not pass the final exam, final skills test, or drops the class.

Class Rebate Program for Splash Employees:

If you average at least 15 hours per week from May 22-August 1 - you will receive \$75 back as a payroll bonus If you average at least 8 hours per week from August 2-October 3 - you will receive another \$75 back as a payroll bonus
